*Mr. Consul,  
Madam Professor,  
Dear healthcare workers,  
Dear Father, dear parents, dearest children!*

I welcome you, and I am happy you have been able to organize this pilgrimage of yours in this Jubilee year, focused on hope. It is a year in which God wants to grant us special graces.

While I was coming to meet you, I felt a joy in my heart because we have the opportunity to give each other hope and love. And there is also another reason: you, dear children and young people, are signs of hope for me. And why? Because I am sure that Jesus is present in you. And wherever He is, there is hope that does not disappoint! Jesus took upon Himself our sufferings, out of love, and so we too, through His love, can join with Him when we are suffering.

And this is proof of friendship. You know: when you are truly friends, the joy of the other person is my joy too, and the pain of the other is also my pain. Once, Jesus said to His disciples: "I know longer call you slaves, because a slave does not know what his master is doing. I have called you friends" (*Jn 15:15*). Dear children, thank you for coming, you are brave! And in this way, you are witnesses of hope for us adults and for your peers.

And thank you to those who have accompanied you: the Ordinary Consul of Luxembourg in Poland, Madam Professor, the organizers of this pilgrimage, the doctors, the nurses, the priest, and above all you, dear parents, pilgrims of hope together with your children.

I entrust you to the Heart of Jesus through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, our Mother. I bless you all and I keep you in my prayers. And you too, please, do not forget to pray for me. Thank you.
